The Daicar - Bata Fellowship Fund was initiated in 1992 to commemorate the lifetime, worldwide contributions of Mr. Otto Daicar to the Bata Corporation. This fellowship fund supports two annual awards for graduate students enrolled in the PhD program of the Department of Physics and Astronomy at the University of Delaware.

The Daicar - Bata prize for the Best Scientific Paper in Physics will be awarded to the PhD student who publishes the best research paper accepted for publication in a scientific journal in physics or astronomy, as judged by a panel. The top three candidates for this prize will present their work during the first fall colloquium.

The second award, the Daicar - Bata prize for Highest GPA in Physics, will be awarded to the PhD student who attains the highest grade point average in physics/astronomy courses at the end of the 6<sup>th</sup> semester in the program.
